
Robert is the father of **Harvard** carbon nano bio weaponry professor **Charles M. Lieber NEVER** speaks about his father or family in his prolific biographies and honors. His grandfather and stepmother, **Leo and Fannie** (**ne Cohen**) **Lieber**, emigrated to Philadelphia in 1893 from Botoşani, Romania, their birthplaces, aboard the SMS Bismark that they boarded in Hamburg, Germany. Lieber's RCA satellite and radar spy father)** on May 6, 1926. Charles' great grandfather Israel (1849–1912) was born in Austria and raised eight children with Goldie (ne Frokler), including Leo, in Botoşani, Romania, Goldie's hometown. Leo was *not* born in Russia as he, or somebody, altered when they crossed out Romania and overwrote Russia on the 1930 census. 

Charles Lieber never mentions his family heritage. His father Robert was born in Philadelphia on May 06, 1926 to Leo and Sophia (ne Malason) Lieber. Sophia (sometimes Sophie) was Leo's second wife and Robert appears to be their only child. Leo was age 50 and Sophia was age 37 when Robert was born.

Leo's first wife, Fannie (ne Cohen) (Robert's stepmother) is the person with whom Leo emigrated from Botoşani, Romania on the SMS Fürst Bismarck via Hamburg, Germany, arriving in New York on Mar. 14, 1892. Fannie and Leo had three children with Fannie, namely Evelyn (b. 1903), Sylvan (b. 1908) and Ruth (b. 1911) according to their 1912 Naturalization Certificate. They were identified "Rou. Yiddish" (Romanian, Jewish) for "Place of birth" for himself and his parents on the 1910 Census. Fannie passed away in 1920. On the 1930 Census, widower Leo had married Sophia (m. Jul. 20, 1923), they had a son Robert (Charles' father). Then oddly, Leo claimed he and his parents were from Russia, not Romania.

Leo was the third child of four brothers and four sisters. His parents were **Israel Lieber** (1849-1912) and Goldie Lieber (ne Frokler) (1857-1930). His father Israel was born in Austria and moved to Botoshani (also Botshani, Botchani, Botoşani), Romania where all eight children were born, and where the greater Lieber family were candy manufacturing proprietors.

To reiterate this glaring alteration of the Lieber census data: Sophie died in 1920. On Jul. 20, 1923, widower Leo Lieber remarried to Sophia Malason (alts. Sophie, Maleson, Meleson) with Rabbi Kline presiding. Sophia's whose mother was born in Russia. As just mentioned, Leo told the U.S. Federal Census takers two different countries of origin. In 1910, Leo declared "Roumania, Yiddish" as his birthplace. In 1930 Leo declared "Russia, Jewish."

Those are the facts, what is the significance of this evident deception?

Oversight? Hardly, the information was repeated numerous times in each census ledger. As shown above, the census taker crossed out "Romania" for father's birthplace and overwrote "Russia."

The strong possibility exists that this 1930 Leo Lieber census record was tampered with later, perhaps while Robert was getting his Top Secret security clearances to work at RCA starting in 1952 (see illustration above).

Why having a Russian father was preferable to a Romanian one is unclear. But, the evidence is overwhelming that Leo was Romanian.

Remarkably, on **Robert Lieber's 1946 Draft Card**, he says his father Leo was an "Unemployed veteran." This is an evident lie. For some reason, Robert besmirched his father Leo's (Charles' grandfather) 50-year-long proprietorship as a candy manufacturer: **Leo Lieber Confectioner**, Philadelphia, PA ("Originator of Crimped Chocolates" — PA Board of Trade, 1920). Leo Lieber died on **Jun. 08, 1955, here is Leo's** *Philadelphia Inquirer* **Obituary** at age 75 having just retired two years earlier in 1953. Here is Leo's **1920 PA Board of Trade** membership verification as a confectioner/manufacturer of note.

Belgium to Luxembourg to Germany. After the war, he earned a degree in Engineering from the University of Miami, and later a Masters Degree in Systems Engineering from Drexel University. He had a long and successful career at RCA, where he earned three Technical Excellence awards for his ground breaking role in developing a satellite tracking and fire-control radars at their Moorestown plant. Bob also received a patent for the early design of circuit boards, which helped revolutionize the manufacture of electrical equipment, contributed to a radar textbook, and at the pinnacle of his career, was awarded the General Sarnoff gold medal for excellence of achievement for all of RCA.








Fig. 1—Viscount Alfred Milner, KG, GCB, GCMG, PC (Mar. 23, 1854 - May 13, 1925). Protégé with Philip Whitwell Wilson of John Ruskin, early imperial socialist; High Commissioner and Various Positions, Southern Africa (1897-1905); started 1st & 2nd Boer Wars in Southern Africa; founded 2nd Boer War Concentration Camp that killed over 60,000 non-English-speaking whites and blacks, including 14,000 white children used in Burroughs Wellcome drug experiments; British Privy Councillor (May 24, 1901); Rio Tinto chairman (1905-1925); Cecil Rhodes disciple; Round Table co-founder; Lord Milner's Kindergarten founder; Pilgrims Society co-founder (Jul. 16, 1902); The First Imperial Press Conference, 1909 organizer (Jun. 05-26, 1909); Empire Press Union co-founder (Jun. 26, 1909); double-crossed Czar Nicholas Romanov (1917); Imperial War Cabinet (WWI) (Spring 1917); League of Nations chief proponent via the Imperial War Cabinet (Dec. 17, 1917); authored Balfour Declaration of 1917.
